We have now entered a period of national mourning that will continue until the end of the State Funeral.

Schools will be provided with advice on the period of national mourning by the Cabinet Office following the death of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. Once details of the funeral are confirmed by the Royal Household, we will write to you with further information.

During the period of national mourning, school will remain open and pupils are expected to attend as per normal.

Today, there will be opportunities to talk about the Queen's death in class. This will be sensitively handled by staff who will reassure and allow questions to be asked and answered. On Monday, we will have a special assembly to celebrate the Queen's life.
