Please find detailed below some information about the upcoming term in Y6.


Learning in Year 6

In English, we will continue to write independently for a range of purposes. We will enjoy a range of poems and learn two by heart to perform: The MisInformation Age by Karl Nova and Jabberwocky by Lewis Carroll.

We will create adverts and write persuasively to encourage the rest of school to visit our stalls during Enterprise Week. Our Leavers' Assembly will encourage script-writing, oracy and performance opportunities.

We will complete our class novel - 'Skellig'by the local, renowned author David Almond. We will explore poems about migration by Michael Rosen and enjoy reading 'The Wind in the Wall' by Sally Gardner and Rovina Cai

Grammar:

We will be consolidating our knowledge of all of the KS2 Grammar and Punctuation curriculum.


Spellings:

Adjectives to describe feelings, settings and characters.

We will learn how to spell the key terminology for Mathematics and Grammar.

In Maths, we will complete our Y6 curriculum by looking at properties of shape and statistics. Over the rest of the term, we will be applying our skills in projects such as Enterprise and other themed projects.

In History, we will be delving into the world of Victorian Britain. We will begin looking at Queen Victoria and her reign.. Through this, we will look at the local area. inventions and the lasting legacy of the Victorians.









In Science, we will be investigating circuits and electricity, building on prior knowledge from lower key stage 2.

In RE, we will be looking at different rituals in world religions and a consolidation of Christianity.

In Art, we will be studying the artist Henri Matissei and the skill of drawing and painting. We will be creating our very own canvas painting.

In D&T, will be applying the knowledge from Science to look at the inventions of Joseph Swan in relation to advanced circuits.













In PE, we will be completing lots of different athletic sports and after half term, we will be learning the skills of life saving at swimming.

In CJ's, we will be learning about Nancy Wake and completing associated missions. We will focus on skills such as perseverance and aspiring to complete challenges.

In Music, we will continue to listen and appraise different pieces of music and will focus on our Leavers assembly towards the end of the term.

In Computing, we will be producing different types of documents using Google programmes in all of our subjects and continuing with our Coding and VEX work.
